**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING  
CITY OF CAMBRIDGE**

The City of Cambridge will conduct a Public Hearing to obtain the views of citizens on community, economic development, and housing needs to be considered for submission of two applications to the Maryland Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG). Citizens will have the opportunity to discuss proposed projects and to provide input on other needs to be considered. The hearing will be held virtually at Council Chambers, 305 Gay Street, Cambridge, Maryland on January 20, 2021 at 4:00 p.m. Citizens may view the meeting on Town Hall Streams or Webex.

The draft application will be available for the public to review on January 19th until January 21 at Department of Public Works, 1025 Washington Street during normal business hours.

Citizens will be furnished with information including but limited to:

- the amount of CDBG funds available for State Fiscal Year 2022;
- the range of activities that may be undertaken with CDBG funds; and
- the proposed projects under consideration by the City.

The Maryland CDBG Program is a federally funded program designed to assist governments with activities directed toward neighborhood and housing revitalization, economic development, and improved community facilities and services. It is administered by the Department of Housing and Community Development.

The Maryland CDBG Program reflects the State's economic and community development priorities and provides public funds for activities which meet one of the following national objectives, in accordance with the federal Housing Community Development Act of 1974, as Amended, that:

1. benefit to low- and moderate-income persons and households;
2. aid in the prevention or elimination of slums or blight; and
3. meet other community development needs to an urgent nature, or that are an immediate threat to community health and welfare.
