Cambridge Crab Run Proposal

Date: Sunday, May 9th, 2021

Start Time: 7:30 am - Half Marathon Start

9:30 am – 5k Start

End Time: All participants off course by 11:30 am

This event is a mirrored run for the 2021 Eagleman 70.3 run course, to be held in mid June. Participants will start from the same start location on Talbot Avenue, and will run the exact course that participants will run for Eagleman 70.3. This event is used to give a preview of the course to runners, and to allow First Responders to see the impact and planning strategies needed for a successful event in June.

This course is different than that of previous years, as the runners will no longer be travelling off of the Westside Bypass, and on to Route 343/Hudson Road. Instead, runners will run TWO LOOPS of the course, with the turnaround being on the circle of the Westside Bypass and another on Oak Street near Riverside Drive.

Local law enforcement agencies are being requested to assist with traffic control for both events. It should be noted that there is a half marathon distance (13.1 miles) at 7:30 am, and then an ADDITIONAL event (5k) that will start exactly TWO HOURS later, at 9:30 am. Participants will have the opportunity to run both events, if they are able to complete the half marathon in 2 hours or less.

Turn by turn directions

- Start on Talbot Avenue
- Right on to Hambrooks Blvd
- Straight to Bellevue Ave
- **Right on Oak Street (Becomes Riverside Dr -> Becomes Bay View Ave)**
- Right on to Hambrooks
- In to St Mary Refuge of Sinners Church and back on to Hambrooks
- CROSS OVER GLASGOW ST
- Left on Holly Terrace
- Right on to Jenkins Creek
- Left on to Westside Bypass
- Right in to Westside Bypass circle and turn around
- FOLLOW COURSE back to Oak Street/Riverside Drive (noted by asterisk above)
- FOLLOW COURSE back to Westside Bypass turn around
- FOLLOW COURSE back to Oak Street/Riverside Drive
- Left on Bellevue Ave (Becomes Hambrooks)
- Left on to Somerset Avenue and finish on right side of driveway of Gerry Boyle Park

Law enforcement agencies will be necessary at the intersections of:

- Talbot Avenue/Hambrooks (Start of events at 0730 and 0930)
- Hambrooks/Glasgow Street
- Holly Terrace/Jenkins Creek
- Jenkins Creek/Westside Bypass
