SUBJECT: Award of Contract for the Cannery Stream Sewer Replacement

Recommendation: That Council award the contract for the Cannery Stream Sewer Replacement to Barker's Landing Excavation, LLC in the amount of \$274,463.79 plus a contingency for unforeseen issues, not to exceed 5%.

Discussion:

Upon completion of the Cannery Stream restoration project in 2017, water quality testing of the stream revealed periodic high levels of fecal coliform, indicating the presence of sewage. No direct source could be found so it was thought that the adjacent sewer line, constructed in 1935, could be a contributing factor. A video inspection of the line indicated the line was in poor condition and rehabilitation of the line is recommended. It was determined that due to the amount of roots and debris in the line, slip lining was not an option and the line should be replaced.

This project will replace approximately 750 linear feet of 12" and 15" sewer line. Bid documents were prepared and an RFP was issued. We received the following three (3) bids:

Retallack & Sons, Inc.	\$355,196.25
David A. Bramble, Inc.	\$465,305.00

The low bidder, Barker's Landing Excavation, has done previous work for the City and is well qualified to complete this project. Therefore, it is our recommendation to award the contract to them.
