Hello Roslyn (and all attached),

I am working on the schedule of events for this year's Day of Resilience, scheduled for Saturday September 11 and Sunday September 12th. I have attached the special event permits and the preliminary schedule for this event. The Day of Resilience theme for 2021 is Honoring our Ancestors by Reconnecting our Roots. This Day of Resilience is significant because it marks exactly one year until our own statue is installed at the courthouse. We will be joined by the US Ambassador of Sierra Leone, Ambassador Sidique Abou-Bakarr Wai and his family. I would like to schedule time with the Mayor to meet with the ambassador while he is visiting Cambridge.

The Day of Resilience will start at Long Wharf fishing pier, at 10:30 am, there will be a short ceremony commemorating the journey of those Africans who were brought to this land by boat and for those who were lost at sea. We will set up a small tent with a few chairs on the grassy area directly next to the UGRR marker at water's edge. We expect approximately 30 participants. The ceremony will be over NLT 11:30 am.

After our traditional courthouse ceremony, we will meet at the Harriet Tubman museum for a VIP lunch, we are inviting any and all available city officials to join us with Ambassador Wai, we would like to talk about the framework for our sister city relationship with Freetown, Sierra Leone.

We are requesting that Race Street be closed off at 1:30 to 8:30 pm to prepared for our evening celebration that includes a fashion show by a Sierra Leone fashion designer, at the black lives matter mural. We are asking the city to provide 6 trash cans for the weekend event. Venders will be set up in Cannery Way on Saturday from 1:30 to 9:00pm

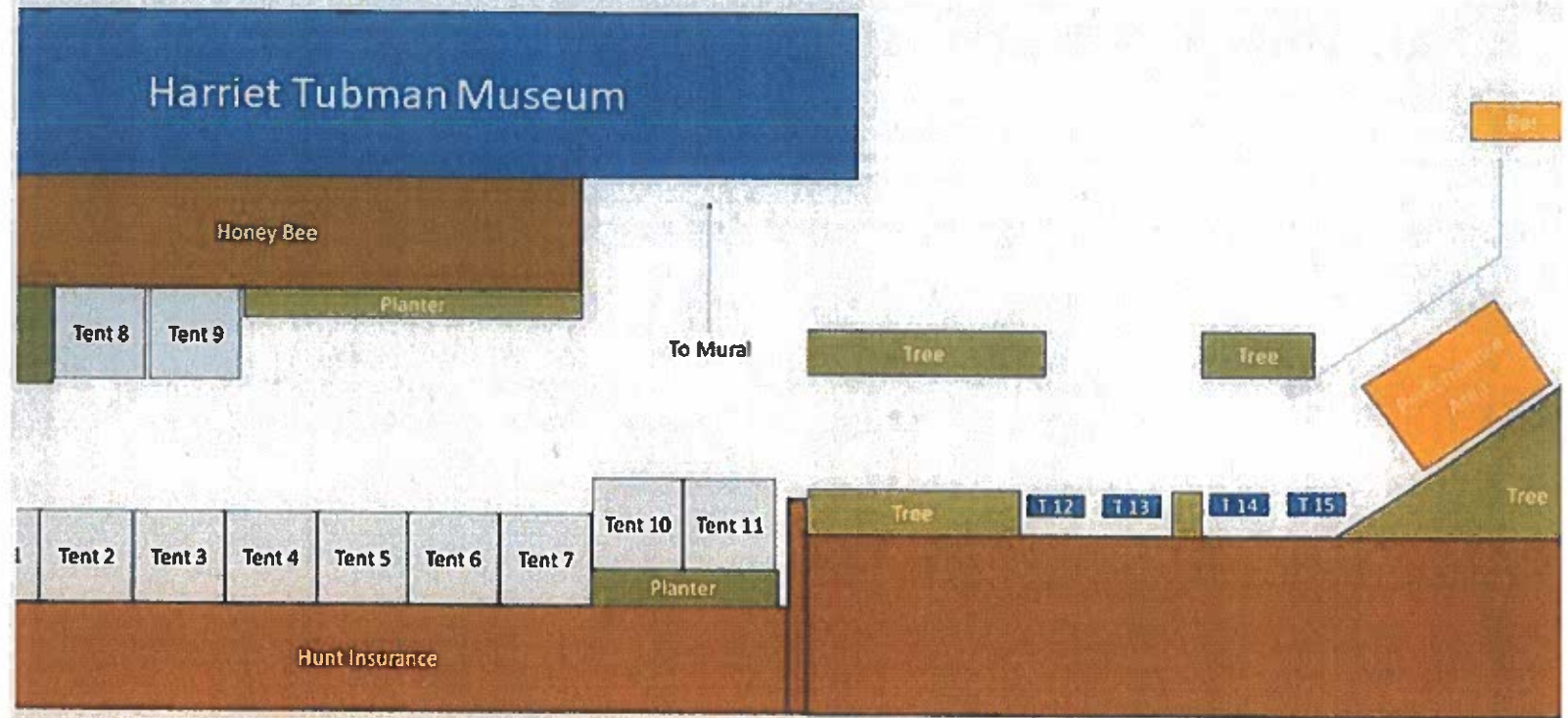
