ORDINANCE NO. 1058

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF CAMBRIDGE, MARYLAND, TO AMEND SECTION 4.2 OF THE CITY'S UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT CODE TO AMEND LAND USE TABLES TO INCLUDE NEW LAND USES AS NEWLY DEFINED AND ALLOW VARIOUS LAND USES IN DIFFERENT ZONE DISTRICTS AS REFLECTED IN THE AMENDED LAND USE TABLES.

WHEREAS, upon consideration of the recommendation of the Planning and Zoning Commission, and upon consideration of the staff of the Department of Planning and Zoning, the comments made at a public hearing before City Council, held on December 14, 2015 the City Council finds that the proposed amendments are needed to protect the public health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on the proposed text amendment was held before the Planning and Zoning Commission on October 6, 2015, following which the Planning & Zoning Commission unanimously recommended that the proposed text amendment be approved; and

WHEREAS, the amendments would add new land uses as recently adopted and allow various land uses in different Zone Districts to aid staff in their review process.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Commissioners of Cambridge, that the City's Unified Development Code is hereby amended as follows:

Section 4.2 is amended by adding newly defined land uses into the tables and allowing land uses in different zone districts as reflected in the amended land use tables, which are attached hereto as Appendix A.


AND BE IT FURTHER enacted and ordained that this Ordinance shall become effective on the tenth (10th) day following the date of adoption.
