SUBJECT: Police Grants

Recommendation: That Council authorize the Police Department to apply to the Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention – Victims of Crime Assistance for a grant of up to \$18,000.

Discussion: The Police Department as an opportunity to apply to the Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention – Victims of Crime Assistance for a grant of up to \$18,000. This will be broken up in to two purchases:

- 1) Acquire ten (10) digital cameras to use for follow up investigations to domestic violence and sexual assault reports (\$10,000). Follow up investigations are necessary for properly documenting evidence of assaults.
- 2) Purchase a one-year subscription to the Lexis-Nexis Accurint Virtual Crime Center to provide the capability of locating suspects and constructing a criminal history for domestic violence, sexual assault and human trafficking offenders. This grant application is due March 8, 2017.

Fiscal Impact: None. Grant does not require matching funds.
