**SUBJECT:** Prioritization of Maryland Department of Housing and Community Development (DCHD) Division of Neighborhood Revitalization, State Revitalization Program Grants

**Recommendation:** That Council prioritize six (6) potential grant applications.

**Discussion:**

On the July 11, 2016 agenda, staff recommends authorization or support for five grant application to DCHD as follows:

Item No. 19: Maryland Ave. Streetlights: \$318, 000

Item No. 20: Façade Improvements (commercial and residential): \$50,000

Item No. 21: Façade Improvement for Am. Legion Hall: \$150,000

Item No. 22: Acquisition and Demolition: \$ TBD

Item No. 23: Hearn Building Phase II Stabilization (letter of support requested by Dorchester County): \$500,000

Item No. 24: Phillips Packing House, Factory F Restoration and Reuse.

The City will have to submit a prioritization if we submit more than one grant application. After voting on submission of each item, staff recommends that Council individually prioritize the applications and then Staff will tally them.
