

To: Talbot Avenue Residents (first block)

Saturday 1st October is the date for the next IRONMAN Maryland race. We fully realize the inconveniences we cause to you as residents that live in such close proximity to the the park. Over the years, we have made every effort to prevent our athletes from parking on your block and therefor making it an even more difficult experience for you. We will continue to do that in the days leading up to the race.

On race day however (the Saturday) we are asking if we can impose on you.

Normally, we allow athletes, spectators and officials to park on the grass, having accessed through Glenburn Ave. During this particular race though, getting cars out during the day presents several issues. For most of the day, our athletes on bikes are leaving and entering the park on Somerset Avenue and from late morning until late at night, runners are leaving and returning through Glenburn.

Our hope this year is to have cars enter the park down Talbot Ave, avoiding Somerset and Glenburn altogether. The majority of cars being parked will belong to competing athletes. This would begin at 4:30 am and the majority of cars would be in by 6:00 am. Normally we send cars in through Glenburn. We would like to avoid that for safety reasons. That is also how the majority of athletes using the shuttle bus enter and having cars and spectators on that narrow dark road can be dangerous.

Once parked most will not be leaving the park until 6:00 pm at the earliest. That will be after they have finished racing.

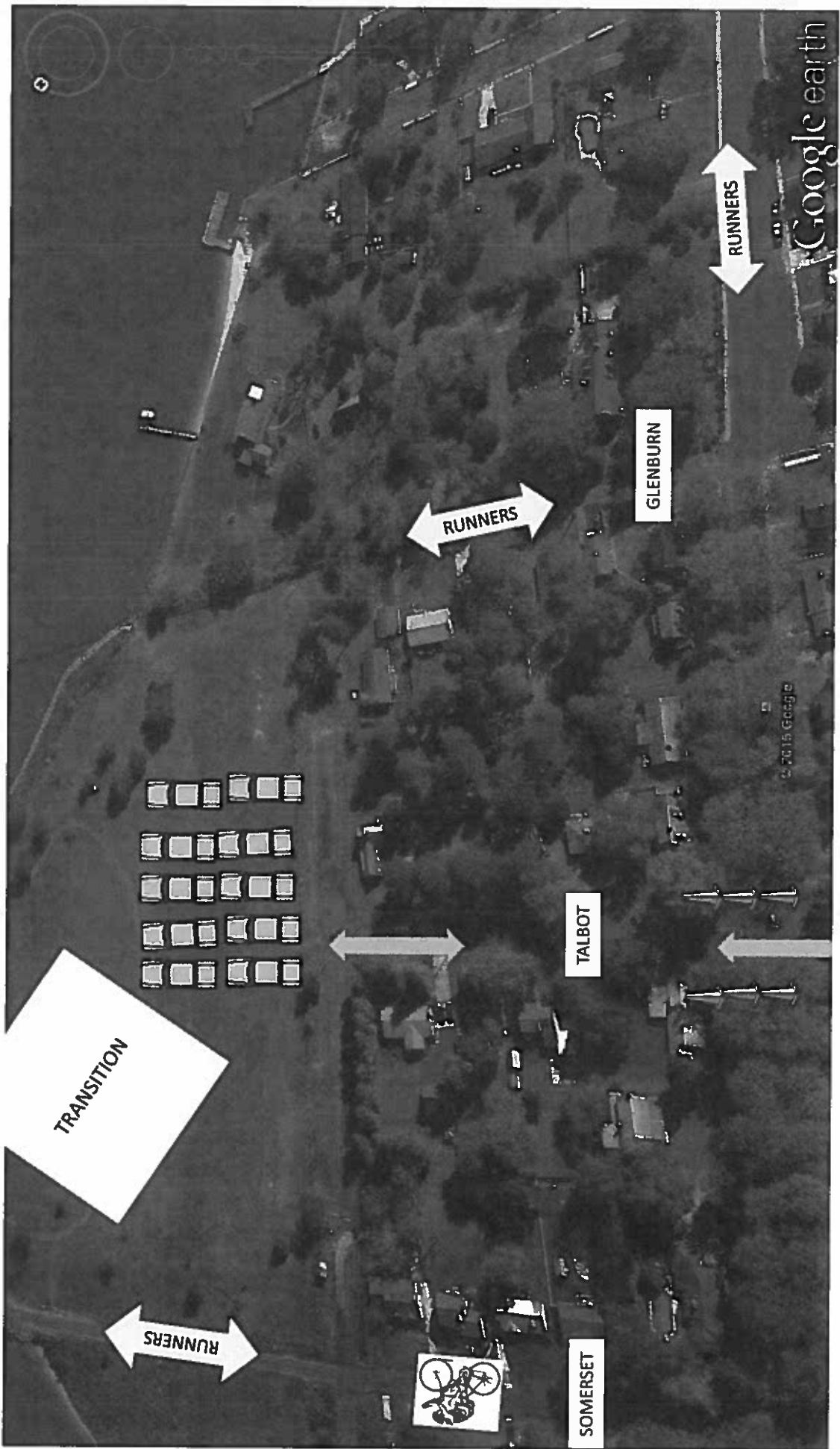
During the day, families and spectators may want to drive out to spectate from other areas on the course. Once all the bikes have returned to the park, we would close off Talbot Ave to all traffic and use Somerset Avenue only.

My staff would ensure that no-one parks on your block and we would do this with signage and traffic cones. We would suggest parking in your driveway and not on the street.

I will be appearing before the City Council on Monday 8th August to formally request this change to our plans. Before I did that, I wanted to explain what we were proposing. On behalf of my athletes and for their safety, I am hoping this meets with your approval.

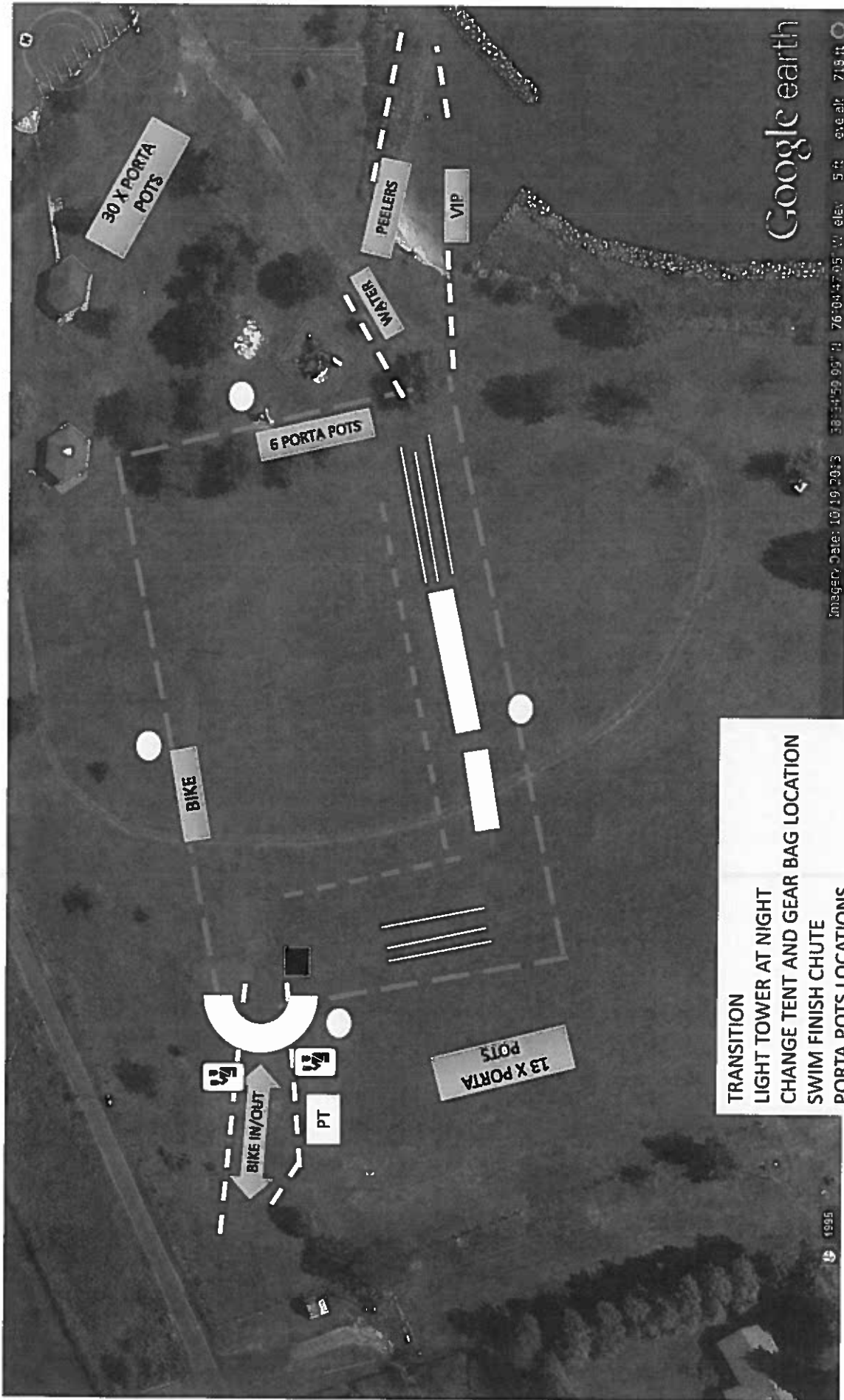
