**SUBJECT:** Police Grant Application for Bike Instructor Training

**Recommendation:** That Council authorize the Police Department to apply to the Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention for a grant of up to \$5,000 for specialized police training.

**Discussion:** The Police Department as an opportunity to apply to the Governor's Office of Crime Control and Prevention for a grant of up to \$5,000 to train one or two officers to become a certified Police Mountain Bike Instructor. This will benefit the department because the new officers will be trained in house and on an as-needed basis rather than sending them to the annual school at the Eastern Short Criminal Justice Academy at a cost of \$155 per student. This instructor will also be certified to maintain the bicycles, which will reduce repair costs.

**Fiscal Impact:** None. Grant does not require matching funds and covers tuition and travel expenses.
