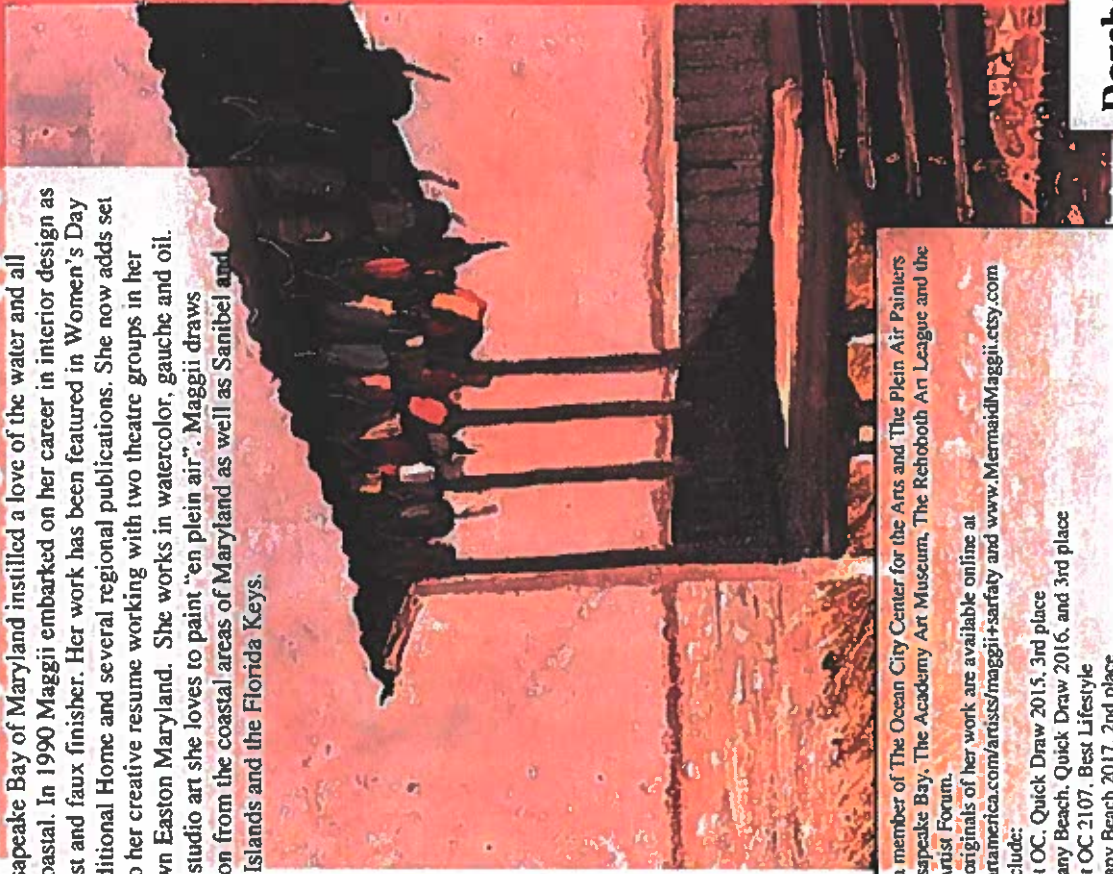
A description of the event is below and a flyer has been enclosed.
