On a motion by Commissioner Sputy Cephass and second by Commissioner Harrington an amendment was made to move \$50,000 from contingency to a new line item for Main Street to fund their program and an additional \$12,000 was moved from contingency to a new line item for the Chamber of Commerce to provide office space. The amendment was approved unanimously.

Tim Ailsworth, Executive Director LGIT and Kenneth Huber PSA and Suzanne Thompson PSA gave a health insurance presentation for the year 2022 insurance proposal.

Chet McWilliams gave a presentation for the 2022 health insurance program.
