#### **Ina Holden Named Director of Administrative Services for the City of Cambridge**

Cambridge, MD (January 26, 2022). Ina Holden, a 25 1/2-year-veteran employee of the City of Cambridge has been named to the newly created position of Director of Administrative Services.

Ms. Holden attended Salisbury University and graduated in May of 1997 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Liberal Studies. As the newly appointed Director of Administrative Services, Ms. Holden's duties will include overseeing the City's human resources, risk management, information technology, and special projects that span across the City's departments. Ms. Holden is one of six department heads under Cambridge's new organizational structure.

Ms. Holden most recently has served as the Public Works Superintendent since June of 2020. City Manager Tom Carroll states, "Ina is perfect for this new role, leading our organizational improvement and safety efforts. The City is fortunate to have someone of her experience and knowledge in the organization who will now be able to modernize our human resources and risk management systems. Her role is central to the City's advancement as an organization."

City Manager Tom Carroll appointed Ms. Holden to this newly created position as part of a broader City of Cambridge reorganization effort. The City of Cambridge is going to have six departments, including: Police, Public Services, Finance, City Engineering, Development, and Administrative Services. The Public Services Department is also a new department combining streets, parks, buildings and grounds, water, and sanitary sewer. The Rescue Fire Company is a volunteer organization which provides fire and hazardous materials services to the community.
