### City of Cambridge Holding September Meetings at the Empowerment Center at 615 B Pine Street in September

Cambridge, MD (September 8, 2023). Exterior restoration of the City Council Chambers entrance and windows began after Labor Day. This renovation work will limit access to the main entrance and will cause some construction debris inside the chambers. For the convenience of the public, the City is moving its evening meetings in September to the Empowerment Center at 615 Pine Street for most of this month.

The first public meeting moved to the Empowerment Center this month is Monday's City Council meeting. This meeting will be held on September 11<sup>th</sup>, 2023, and begins at 6 p.m. On-site parking is very limited, though nearby street parking is plentiful. Those wishing to attend may want to come a little early to ensure they can park and walk to the Empowerment Center.

This meeting, like all Council meetings, will also be televised on Town Hall Streams.
