




Cambridge Bikeway Study Public Input Opportunities



The City of Cambridge has been awarded a grant from the Maryland Department of Transportation to design new bikeways. Trail systems and bicycle networks are an important amenity for recreation, public health, traffic safety, economic development, environmental sustainability, and quality of life. However, to be an attractive option, bicycle and trail networks need to be safe, convenient, comfortable, and connected. Cambridge already has some areas with high-quality bicycle and trail infrastructure. Connecting network gaps and removing barriers with more high-quality bicycle infrastructure can help the City of Cambridge accommodate more people, connect more places, and reap more benefits. The goals of this study are to find the best way to:

- Connect neighborhoods to the core of downtown Cambridge with bikeways
- Improve pedestrian and bicycle safety
- Provide enhanced recreational amenities serving the local community and visitors
- Encourage tourism for heritage and environmental appreciation with connections to scenic areas and local destinations
