

Bulk Items

Bulk items are collected on your last garbage day of each week. Public Services encourages residents to call prior to placing bulk items out. To schedule a bulk item pick-up, contact Department of Public Services at 410-228-1955.

City of Cambridge considers the following bulk trash:

- ✓ Furniture
- ✓ Yard Trimmings (bagged or bundled)
- ✓ Bagged Vegetation (Grass Clippings, Leaves, Etc.)
- ✓ Limbs (Bagged or bundled and less than 4 feet in length, 4 inch diameter or less)
- ✓ Box Springs
- ✓ Mattresses (Similar Items)

The following are considered white goods and will also need to be scheduled for a pick-up:

- ✓ Washers
- ✓ Dryers
- ✓ Dishwashers
- ✓ Stoves
- ✓ Ranges
- ✓ Hot Water Heaters
- ✓ Refrigerators
- ✓ Freezers
- ✓ Air Conditioners

Any items that contain Freon, and similar items, the City of Cambridge will pick-up.

Unacceptable: Items which are **not** collected by Chesapeake Waste including, without limitation, items such as:

- Tenant clean outs
- Personal Property
- Chattels (Furniture)
- Eviction items
- Room carpeting and padding
- Construction and/or demolition material and debris or Hazardous waste of any kind.
- Tires
- Tree limbs larger than 4 inches in diameter or greater than 4 feet in length.
- Tree limbs not tied or bundled
- Dead Animals
- Containers weighing more than 50 pounds

If there are any unacceptable items you want to dispose of, please contact Dorchester County Beulah Landfill located at 6815 East New Market-Ellwood Road, Hurlock, MD 21643 or call (410)-943-1700. Residents can also visit their website at www.docogonet.com.

Note: Tenant clean outs, personal property, eviction items, and chattels (furniture) shall not be placed out for garbage if exceeding the trash limit. The trash limit is 2 cubic yards per collection. Department of Public Services will **not** be held responsible for uncollected items. City violations will be issued to resident(s) by the City's Code Enforcer if the items are left unattended in front of the residence for a period of time.
