City of Cambridge Department of Public Services to Provide Additional Yard Debris Collections

Cambridge, MD (January 10, 2024). Preliminary reports from the City's various departments indicate that very little damage occurred in Cambridge from last evening's storms, but residents and homeowners of Cambridge woke up this morning to yards filled with downed limbs and debris from last evening's high winds.

The City's Department of Public Services (a combination of the former Public Works Department and the Municipal Utilities Commission) will provide additional collection of yard waste to assist residents with their yard clean up.

Crews will pick up storm debris stacked at the edge of the property. Residents should not, under any circumstances, place limbs across sidewalks or sticking out into the road. Cambridge Public Services crews will not collect any limbs larger than 4 inches in diameter and debris should be neatly stacked with the cut ends facing the street for the safety of the crews performing the collections. Any larger debris will need to be removed privately.
