

## **2/7/24- NOTICE OF SANITARY SEWER OVERFLOWS**

As a result of high tide, the Department of Public Services is reporting that a sanitary sewer overflow occurred on Oakley Street at the sanitary sewer manhole closest to the waterfront. The area of the overflow have been cleaned, a sign has been posted, and an overflow report is being filed with the Maryland Department of the Environment. The public is advised to avoid contact with any standing water in the vicinity of an overflow. There is no threat of contamination of the local drinking water supply.
