

3/23/24- NOTICE OF SANITARY SEWER OVERFLOWS

As a result of heavy rains and high tide, the Department of Public Services is reporting that a sanitary sewer overflow occurred in six locations: 1. Oakley Street at the sanitary sewer manhole closest to the waterfront, 2. Water Street at Vue de Leau, 3. Water Street between Mill St. and Choptank Ave, 4. Hambrooks Blvd. near Belvedere, 5. S. Regulator Dr. between F&S Dr. and Markley Ct., and 6. At the pump station on Maple Dam Road (south of CSDHS). The areas of the overflows have been cleaned, signs have been posted, and an overflow report is being filed with the Maryland Department of the Environment. The public is advised to avoid contact with any standing water in the vicinity of an overflow. There is no threat of contamination of the local drinking water supply.
