**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS
THE COMMISSIONERS OF CAMBRIDGE
PROPOSED ORDINANCE NOS. 1246 & 1247**

Notice is hereby given that the Commissioners of Cambridge will hold public hearings on Monday, June 9, 2025, during their regular meeting beginning at 6:00 p.m. at the Council Chambers, 305 Gay Street, Cambridge, Maryland, to receive public input and comment regarding the following proposed Ordinances:

1. Ordinance No. 1246 which, if passed, would authorize expenditures for the City of Cambridge for the fiscal year commencing on July 1, 2025, and ending on June 30, 2026 as follows:

2. Ordinance No. 1247 which, if passed, would authorize a real property tax levy of \$0.8096 for each \$100.00 of assessed valuation of real property and a personal property tax levy of \$1.69 for each \$100.00 of assessed valuation of personal property in the City for the fiscal year commencing on July 1, 2025, and ending on June 30, 2026.

The foregoing constitutes a fair summary of proposed Ordinance Nos. 1246 and 1247 as introduced by the Commissioners of Cambridge during their public meeting held on May 12, 2025.
