## **Consumer Can Gets Answers and Advocacy For Insurance Matters**

To provide an understanding of medical and homeowner insurance policies and serve as an advocate for consumers in related matters, the People's Insurance Counsel was created as a division of the Office of the Attorney General of Maryland by the Maryland Legislature in 2005.

The PICD has two major functions: 1) review all the medical professional liability insurance and homeownership insurance matters before the Commissioner of the Maryland Insurance Administration, and 2) discuss citizen concerns about matters related to medical professional liability and homeowners' insurance.

While PICD cannot serve as the attorney of record in these issues, they can and will advocate for your interests. The personnel want to hear your concerns and provide relevant information to help resolve your issues.
