Cambridge works to help residents

As the Federal Government shutdown continues, Cambridge residents may find themselves in situations where they must make hard choices. Mayor LaJan Cephas Bey said, “In this time of national uncertainty, it is important that we take action at the city level to provide stability and reassurance for our residents.”

City Manager Glenn Steckman is looking at ways to help residents persevere. “To support families in this time of turmoil,” Mr. Steckman said, “we will be suspending utility disconnections for a two-week period.” This, Mr. Steckman stressed, is a temporary suspension, which will not forgive the bill, but will provide some grace as city administration continues to monitor the federal shutdown and its impact on support services.
