

Actualización meteorológica

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El ciclo de mareas para mañana por la mañana en el sur del Condado de Dorchester pasará de moderado a mayor.

El problema es que la marea baja no alcanzará el umbral de inundación, y la marea alta de la tarde también estará ligeramente por arriba de lo normal. Esto probablemente dificultará los viajes y sera potencialmente peligroso en las zonas donde se produzcan grandes inundaciones. Por favor, use precauciones extremas al encontrar agua en las carreteras.

- Precipitación total de 1" - 1.5"
- Es probable que hayan inundaciones costeras hoy y el jueves. Se esperan inundaciones costeras generalizadas de leves a moderadas, con inundaciones mayores localizadas en las zonas sur del Condado de Dorchester.
- Las ráfagas de viento de entre 20s y 30s millas/h serán prevalentes durante las próximas 72 horas.

Coastal Flood Warnings and Advisories

In effect through tonight-Thursday night

- **Coastal Flood Warning** - locations around the upper James River, the Rappahannock River, and middle and upper Chesapeake Bay
- **Coastal Flood Advisory** - locations along the York River, lower James River, lower bay, Virginia Beach, and eastern Currituck and Worcester counties.

● Inundation of 1-2 ft above ground level in vulnerable areas (Up to around 2 ft along the upper bay).

● Flooding will likely result in road closures and could threaten vulnerable homes and businesses.

● Do not drive through flooded roads.

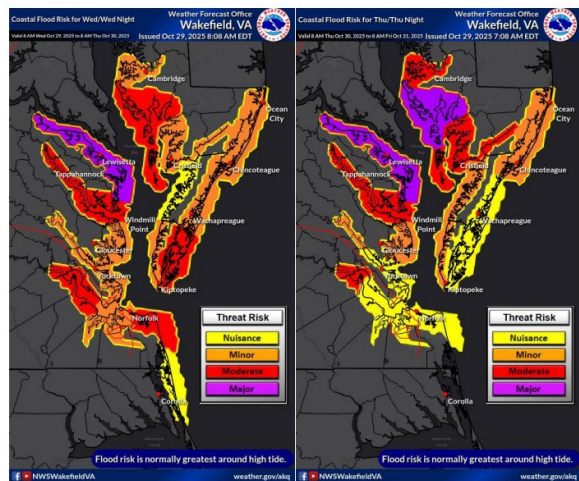

Tidal Flooding- Today & Tomorrow

Nuisance	Shallow flooding only in the most vulnerable locations. Expect around a half foot of inundation.
Minor	Up to 1 foot of inundation possible in vulnerable locations.
Moderate	1 to 2 feet of inundation expected. Water will extend inland from the waterfront.
Major	2 to 3 feet or more of inundation expected. Flooding will extend well inland.

- Widespread **MINOR** to **MODERATE** tidal flooding expected today, with **localized MAJOR** flooding possible across the upper bay with the Thursday morning high tide.
- Widespread **MINOR** to **MODERATE** tidal flooding is again expected on Thursday across the upper bay and MD beaches.

Flood risk / impacts will typically be greatest around each high tide for the given day. Images represent the peak flood category / impact expected.

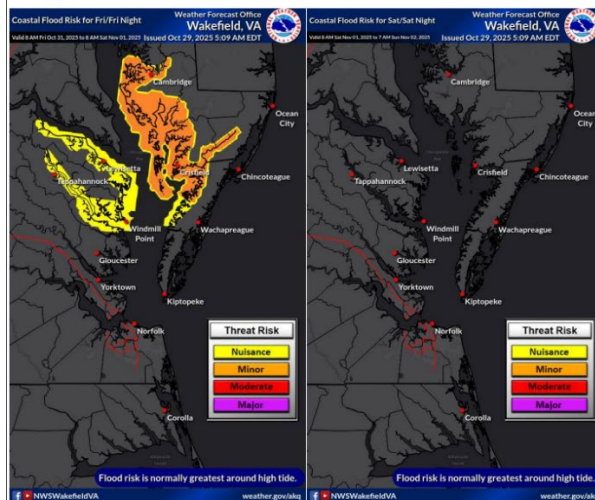

Major	2 to 3 feet or more of inundation expected. Flooding will extend well inland.

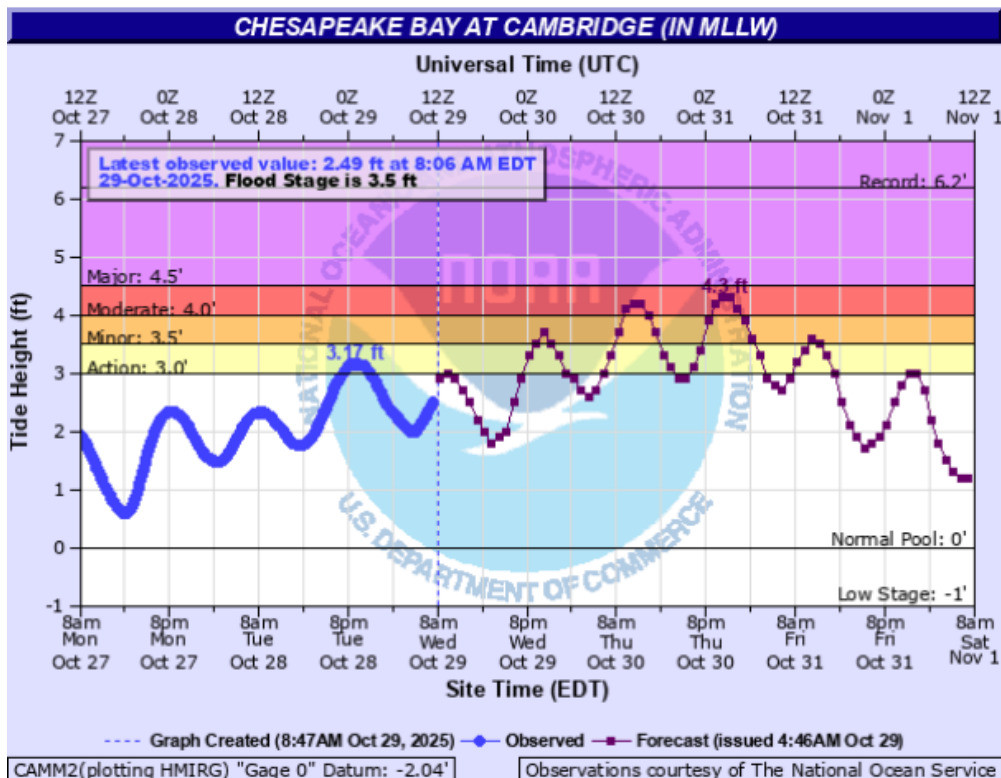
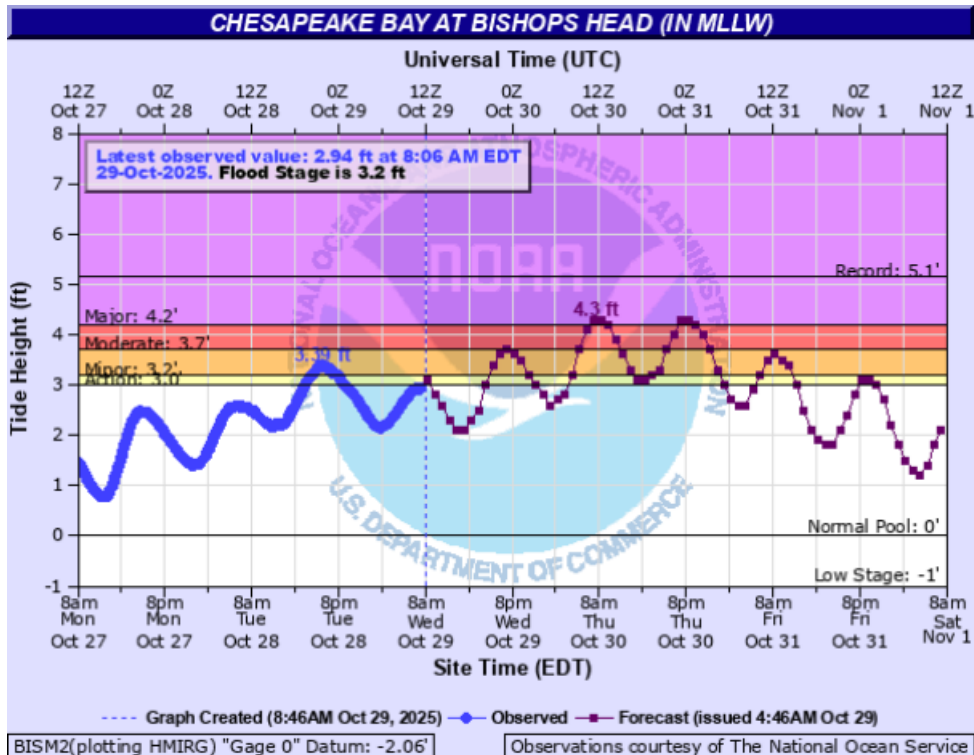
- Nuisance to **MINOR** tidal flooding is expected across the upper bay on Friday as winds become W.
- Water levels fall Friday into the weekend.

Flood risk / impacts will typically be greatest around each high tide for the given day. Images represent the peak flood category / impact expected.

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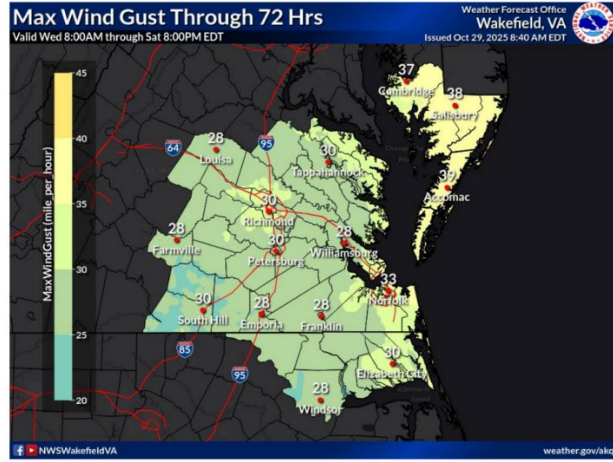
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Maximum Wind Gust Forecast
