Like It or Not, We Have to Talk About Trash

CAMBRIDGE, MD – Trash collection in Cambridge is an important activity and everyone has a role to play. The street crews are doing their part, from before dawn until dusk, to make sure all the garbage cans, in the proper place at the curb, are picked up on the assigned days.

To help them accomplish this fairly large mission, residents have an equally important role to play. Please make a note of these obligations:

- Please bag all trash and place all bags inside your provided garbage can.
- Please do not throw loose trash in the garbage can. It could end up on the street or blowing about the neighborhood because it can escape as the garbage can is being dumped.
- Please do not place garbage cans at their curbside pick-up location until after 5 pm on the evening before your assigned pick-up day.
- Please retrieve all garbage cans from the curb as soon as possible after the trash is collected, but absolutely no later than the following morning.

If everyone does their part, this necessary and important function in our community can be completed smoothly and efficiently.

Upcoming dates to remember related to trash collection (and other city services) are as follows:

- City offices are closed on Thursday, Nov. 27th and Friday, Nov. 28th in celebration of the Thanksgiving holiday season.
- Residential customers with trash pickup scheduled for Thursday and Friday will not have trash collection on Thursday, Nov. 27th or Friday, Nov. 28th. Please do not put your garbage cans at the curb on those days.
