Cambridge Residents, be prepared

As we approach the weekend and a predicted snowstorm that is almost inevitable, here are a few things the City of Cambridge wants you to know, remember, and act upon:

- If the prediction of snow is for 3 inches or more, please assume there will be a call for a snow emergency and do not park your vehicles along the designated snow emergency routes. These routes are clearly marked, but if you are unsure, [click here](#) to see the city map detailing the routes.
- Please remember that you are responsible for clearing the snow and ice from public walkways within 24 hours of the end of the snowfall, to make sure the areas are passable for pedestrians so they do not have to walk in the street.
- Please remember that city ordinances require that all animals be brought inside when temperatures are at or below 32°F. Please do not leave your animals outside.
- Please assist your neighbors, especially the elderly or differently-abled. Not everyone can clear their walks and doorways without help and your assistance could be central to keeping them safe.
- Avoid unnecessary travel. This makes it possible for city crews to clear the roadways, and for emergency vehicles to quickly navigate in less than ideal circumstances.
- Please check the city's website and area news sites for closings, delays and other information that will help you understand and navigate the situation.

Please stay safe and, for those of you who love it, enjoy the snow!
